Notice of Changes in *Circular 6* (Regulations and Procedures for Pedigreed Seed Crop Production) Effective in 2017

The following changes were approved by the CSGA Board of Directors to become effective in 2017. A complete revised 2017 version of the *Regulations and Procedures for Pedigreed Seed Crop Production (Circular 6)* will be available on the [CSGA website](#) and hardcopy versions will be available from the CSGA office.

Effective in 2017, the following changes are made in the CSGA *Regulations and Procedures for Pedigreed Seed Crop Production (Circular 6)*:

- 1. Maximum Impurity Standards for all wheat types (durum is not included) are revised in Table. 2.4.4.** The standard for off-types or other varieties of the same crop kind for the production of Foundation seed crops remains unchanged at 1. For the production of Registered seed crops the standard is revised from 1 to 3. For the production of Certified seed crops the standard is revised from 5 to 8. (Section 2)
- 2. Maximum Impurity Standards for Bean, Chickpea, Fababean, Lentil, Lupin and Peas are revised in Table. 3.4.4.** The standard for off-types or other varieties of the same crop kind for the production of Foundation seed crops remains unchanged at 1. For the production of Registered seed crops the standard is revised from 1 to 2. For the production of Certified seed crops the standard remains unchanged at 5. (Section 3)
- 3. Industrial Hemp Standards are revised to modernize the standards.** The revisions relate to: a) previous land use; removal of tobacco as an unacceptable previous crop and decreasing the number of years required between hemp crops b) reducing the number of inspections and c) crop standards; removal of reference to “harmful contaminants” and a slight reduction in the isolation requirements.
