Bean includes Field, Garden, White, Coloured, Navy or Dry edible type Bean.

General Requirements for All Pedigreed Seed Crops

The basic standards for all crops are set out in [General Requirements for All Pedigreed Seed Crops](#). In addition, the following standards apply to Bean.

Land Requirements

| Inspected Crop | Must NOT be grown on land which: |

Crop Inspection

Bean crops must be inspected at flowering.

Crop Standards

Isolation

Minimum Isolation Distances Required from an Inspected Crop to Other Crops:

| | |
|---|---------------------|
| 1. Varietal Purity – Foundation | Distance |
| a. Inspected pedigreed Bean seed crop | 3 meters (10 feet) |
| b. Non-pedigreed Bean crop | 20 meters (65 feet) |
| 2. Varietal Purity – Registered and Certified | Distance |
| a. Any crop of Bean | 3 meters (10 feet) |
| 3. Mechanical Purity – Foundation, Registered and Certified | Distance |
| a. Chickpea, Fababean, Lentil, Lupin, Pea, Soybean | 2 meters (6 feet) |

Maximum Impurity Standards

- Varietal Purity (off-types/other varieties on average in 10,000 plants)
 - Foundation – 1
 - Registered – 2
 - Certified – 5
